All successful applicants will be required to take and pass an exam with 70% or higher. Once registered, those that wish to remain listed as a Registered SWPPP Reviewer will be required to complete 8 hours of continuing education, complete a minimum of 10 SWPPP reviews, and 10 site plan reviews every two years.

Registered SWPPP Reviewer (RSR) Requirements

Initial Registration (2 year period)

1. Classroom Instruction (using USWAC subcommittee approved curriculum)
 - a. 8 hours instruction including exam – 70% passing score required
 - b. Cost \$195 Local and State Government, \$395 Private groups.
2. Prequalification
 - a. 10 Site Plan Reviews
 - b. 10 SWPPP Reviews
 - c. Working knowledge of current General Construction Permit (GCP)
 - d. Working knowledge and understanding of BMP's
 - e. Knowledge of State and Federal Land development permit
3. Certifying Examination
 - a. 70% passing score required.
 - b. Test may be retaken within 1-year time frame.
 - c. Applicants will not be registered until they pass the exam and completed all requirements listed above.
 - d. Applicant certifies they have high school diploma or GED.

Applicants not passing the exam within the 1-year time limit are required to restart the Registration process..

Continuing Registration

Requirements to maintain the RSR Registration are:

1. Minimum of 10 formal documented SWPPP reviews conducted over the 2 year registration period.
2. 8 hours of Continuing Education in Storm Water approved courses over 2 year period.
3. Payment of \$25 registration fee.
